

These are our current protocols for COVID-19. Please check back closer to the date as the protocol may change.

Preparing for Your Arrival

You will be asked to fill out an online COVID entry form to enter CRS which will be shared with you before the date of your Mah Jongg game once you register to join us.

Our Synagogue is following all guidelines related to the frequency of cleaning and disinfecting our spaces. High touch surfaces (doors, doorknobs, tables, chairs, light switches, sinks, and toilets) are cleaned throughout the day, and deep cleaned and disinfected nightly. Our staff will be doing rounds hourly to ensure the building remains clean and disinfected.

Please do not arrive more than 15 minutes before the time allotted for the game.

When You Arrive at the Synagogue

Everyone must wear masks to gain entry to the synagogue and throughout your time in the building.

All those who enter the Synagogue will have their temperature checked. If you have a temperature above 100.0 F, you will not be allowed to enter.

We have decreased the capacity of our two elevators. Signage will indicate that occupants face different directions.

If choosing to use the stairwell, we ask that you use the right-hand side if you are going up or down the stairs. If you are going up or down the stairs and see someone coming in the opposite direction, please stop at the landing and allow the person to pass. As much as possible, stay to the right when walking through the hallways of the 5th floor and follow the floor arrows.

When You Get to the 6th Floor to Enter the Roof

Please utilize the Purell station provided and find a seat at one of the tables to begin playing Mah Jongg. The group will be limited to 12 people (3 groups of 4), so please only sit at a table if there is an open spot.

In Our Building

We will keep track of all participants so we have an accurate record of who is in the building at any given time.

All adults on the floor are required to wear masks at all times.

Once the game/event has ended, you must exit the building and not visit other floors.

Communication

If someone tests positive for COVID-19, we will report that there has been an exposure to all the participants present, without naming the person. We will let you know if you were in close contact with the individual. We will also report it to the Department of Health. We will then follow their guidance.

We will keep you informed in the event that everybody who was within 6 feet of the person who has tested positive (for at least 15 minutes) and related quarantine information.

We recognize that all these safety measures for entering our building will take some getting used to. Our goal is to make everyone as comfortable as possible so you can still have fun.
